



## Frequently Asked Questions – Registration 2022

### How do I register?

All new and returning players must register online. If you have not previously registered your child, create an account as a parent first then register your child as a player. Go to [www.playfootball.com.au](http://www.playfootball.com.au) to register.

### When should I register?

Registrations will open **11 February 2022** and will close on **Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> March 2022**. This allows the club to nominate the correct teams for the 2022 season, and gives our kids the best chance of being included in their appropriate age group team.

Late registrations will be considered based on team availability. New players to the club are welcome to attend two weeks of pre-season training prior to registering.

### Is there another way to register?

No. All registrations **must** go through the PlayFootball registration online system via smartphone, tablet, or desktop computer. If you do not have access please consult the Team Manager, Coach, or email [registrar.kjsc@gmail.com](mailto:registrar.kjsc@gmail.com) for assistance.

### I cannot remember my password for the account I used to register in previous years, what can I do?

## **I tried to sign-up but I didn't get a confirmation email from PlayFootball.**

## **My name, child's name, or date of birth is incorrect in the PlayFootball system.**

Before you complete registration, email [PlayFootball.support@ffa.com.au](mailto:PlayFootball.support@ffa.com.au) with proof of correct details (scan of license, birth certificate, Medicare card etc.) The account holder can update other details online.

## **I am trying to register my child but the photo upload isn't working.**

ID Photographs are only required for the Juniors competitions (U12 and older). MiniRoos and Social registration does not require a photo to be uploaded. If you are experiencing difficulties you can email an ID photo of your child to

### **This is my child's first season in Australia since playing overseas. Do I need a transfer clearance?**

Yes. All players aged 10 years or over that have played overseas must apply for an **International Transfer Certificate** (ITC) as per FIFA regulations. This can take 6 weeks and players cannot play matches until the ITC has been approved. ### **If my child's registration is not yet approved can she still play a game?**

No. All players participating in any games must be registered.

### **Who runs the training sessions and at what time?**

All players U12 and younger participate in the KANO skills training program. Please refer to the Training and Development section on our website for current training schedules.

Training for U13 to U17 teams are run by club coaches, usually twice per week. Please refer to Training and Development section on our website or the Team App for up-to-date training times.

Training is held at the club grounds, JJ Holland Park, either on the main oval or on the synthetic soccer field. Some older teams may also choose to use Newmarket Reserve. Council regulations do not permit players participating in pre-season training (prior to 1<sup>st</sup> April) to wear studded boots on the main oval.

### **What is Kano Football?**

Kano Football (Formerly T-3 Australia) is an organisation that helps community clubs assist children to develop their football game with the support of their parents and club coaches. Please visit their website for more information [kano-football.com.au](http://kano-football.com.au)

## **How will teams be decided?**

Team selection is at the discretion of the club's coaches. If there is a specific reason that you require your child to play in a certain team please speak to the coach of that team.

## **I am new to the club, how do I find out more information?**

Please visit [www.kfjsc.com.au](http://www.kfjsc.com.au) and download the free Team App [www.teamapp.com](http://www.teamapp.com) then search for **KJSC**.

## **Do I join Team App with my own details or the details of my child?**

Use your own details when creating a free Team App account, not the details of your child. The admin of your team will enter your child as a player into the app and then align your account to the player's membership. Other parent's can also sign up and receive the same notifications and correspond with the team.

## **What uniforms do I need and how do I order them?**

Uniforms are ordered using the club's Team App online store. Juniors and MiniRoos players need a pair of blue shorts, blue socks, and yellow socks. These are available as a package for \$50.

Juniors players (U12 and older) are required to purchase their own match top, which is available for \$45. MiniRoos players (U11 and younger) are supplied a match top that must be returned at the end of the season.
