The North Melbourne Huddle



During the Easter break, the North Melbourne Football Club led a multi-sports event at North Melbourne Community Centre, giving 60 kids from diverse backgrounds aged from 3 to 13 a taste of many different sports.

Netball was proudly represented by Coach Violet Cowie from the Cockatoos and Coach Scott Maguire from the Cats, who spent two hours introducing the kids to the greatest sport of all.

Price Rises for Spring Season (starting July)

The club will reluctantly raise prices next season, the 2023 Spring season beginning in July, due to various cost increases.

The club membership fee will now include GST and therefore rise from \$280 to \$308 – or, for a family registration, rise from \$520 to \$572.

We'll also start passing on Gate Fees for teams that play at Parkville. In the past, Parkville charged spectators a few bucks at the door – you may remember long lines snaking down the front steps! – before giving up on that and charging clubs directly.

The club absorbed this while we could, but from next season will charge \$48 per player for teams that play at Parkville. (That's almost all of them.) It comes out to around \$2.80 per game, and covers entry for all spectators to all games.

Active Kids Vouchers

You might be eligible to save \$200 per child via the Active Kids program – see https://www.getactive.vic.gov.au/vouchers/

This program has a strict and awkward timeline, which doesn't line up with netball's registration window. But eligible families can claim a refund of \$200 per child on fees you've already paid for the Autumn season by applying before the deadline of May 10.

Families facing financial hardship can also seek scholarships from **the Jean Cowan Bequest**.

Training Venues - Now & the future



Since 2020, we've had to spread teams across different training venues – six at once, last year! – while waiting for the rebuilt Kensington Community Recreation Centre.

This year, we've managed to put a lot of teams into North Melbourne Recreation Centre. But everything is makeshift until the KCRC (to renamed **Kensington Community Aquatic and Recreation Centre**) reopens, which is now slated for early 2025. After a series of delays, the price tag has risen from \$25M to \$68M, which makes it a heck of a large expenditure for City of Melbourne.

The new Rec Centre will have three indoor multi-purpose courts, raising the exciting possibility of training six teams at once. Twelve in two hours! That could be the whole club in one place over two nights.

KJNC Alumni vs the Coaches

There are now two Kensington Open teams (the Kites and Kestrels – not to be confused with our Junior versions) playing in the Parkville league. Some of these players had grown out of 17 & Under, and the rest wanted to stick together as a team!

The Kestrels found themselves in the same division as a team of KJNC coaches, the Blueys. In Round 5, youth faced off against experience, with the older, wiser heads prevailing... for now.

Netball Victoria has over 180 affiliated associations and leagues, many running selective Representative programs to support and develop netball skills.

As a member of the Parkville Netball Association (PNA), Kensington players are eligible to trial for the Parkville Netball Representative Team. PNA offer an annual program, with selections held towards the end of the year.
